## HOCKLEY VALLEY BECAME 'HAWKSLEY' VALLEY THIS NOVEMBER

*Juno winner, Hawksley Workman, played Hockley Hall on November 8th and 9th*

Hockley Valley became Hawksley Valley as iconic Canadian artist, Hawksley Workman, along with his band The Wolves took to the stage of our historic community hall on November 8th and 9th.

A staple of the Canadian arts scene for almost 20 years, Workman boasts a catalogue of 15 solo releases, and accolades including JUNO nods and wins, and widespread critical acclaim.

"We were incredibly lucky," says Diane Walmsley, one of the show's organizers. "Hawksley Workman has played venues like Massey Hall and The Olympia in Paris, and has opened for the likes of David Bowie, Morrissey, and The Cure. That he agreed to play our hall is truly a dream come true." Workman was the second Juno winner to grace the hall's stage this year. We hosted

Fred Eaglesmith on May 25<sup>th</sup>. Attendees of the shows expressed great interest and enthusiasm in regularly seeing high caliber Canadian music so close to home.

"Why not enjoy our own back yard?" asked Walmsley, "Let's bring incredible Canadian artists to our historic little hall, rather than cram ourselves into Toronto."
